- Welds pipe and structural steel from 1" to 48" to CODE ASME, API, 100% X-RAY
- Welds brackets and braces and use grinders. Positions pieces to be welded into jigs, holding fixtures, guides and steps uses measuring instruments and hand tools.
- Performs position welds on code materials
- Proficient in flame and plasma cutting torches
- Experience reading and understanding blueprints
- Operates basic cutting equipment
- Layout and mark weld points on parts or sub-assemblies using rule, square, scribe or templates and two hole pins
- Reads blueprints and performs own fit-up
- Works with different types and sizes of pipe and structural steel
- Operates cutting equipment
- Operates iron worker, overhead cranes, rigging, pipe threading machine, welding machine, tube bending machine, and various pneumatic hand tools safely
